- Due to the fact that both Christmas Day and New Year's Day fall on a SUNDAY **TRASH COLLECTION WILL NOT BE DELAYED THIS HOLIDAY SEASON.** Please place your items to the curb by 7:00 am on your regularly scheduled collection day.

- *Watch your waste!*



Did you know that more household waste is produced between Thanksgiving and New Year's Day than any other time of the year? Try keeping your waste generation to a minimum this holiday season by using reusable shopping bags and recycled wrapping paper.

Don't forget to take advantage of your curbside recycle collection for shirt boxes, toy packaging and plastic bags marked with chasing arrows recycle symbol.

On your collection day, please take care to ensure that the weight of any separate bag or container does not exceed **50 pounds**.

- *Live Christmas Tree Collection Schedule*

Live Christmas Trees will be collected as yardwaste beginning Monday, January 2 and ending Friday, January 13, 2012. Trees must be free of tinsel, ornaments, etc. Trees 12 foot or larger must be cut in half.

- *Yardwaste Collection Schedule*

Yardwaste will continue to be collected through the week ending Friday, January 13, 2012. Yardwaste collection will resume on Monday, April 3, 2012.
